

SWT Blythe Student Prize 2017



The SWT Blythe Student Prize will be conferred to a student for a piece of work produced in the last academic year (2016) from the University of Tasmania's School of Architecture + Design.

Eligibility: The Prize is open to students who have been enrolled at any level of the Architecture/ Environmental Design course at the University of Tasmania during 2016.

Prize value: There is a cash prize of \$400, payable to the Prize recipient. The TAS Chapter will also assist the recipient with arrangements to spend a period of time (minimum two weeks) in an architectural office or allied organisation of the student's choice. The offer to assist is valid for twelve months from the presentation of the Prize. The recipient must meet any travel or related costs associated with the work experience.

Submission requirements:

1. Submission material should be in its original form as submitted to the School for assessment, in hard copy, and be fully explanatory. Models are not to be submitted, but may be requested if required during adjudication.
2. Submissions shall include the original project brief.
3. Completed entry form.
4. An A1 **portrait style** panel mounted on foam core to represent your project in the Awards Exhibition is optional.

Closing Date: Entries close Friday 31 March, 2017, at 9:00am and are to be submitted to:
