EMERGING ARCHITECT: Member category member who attained architectural registration for the first time within the last three years. (2022 - 2025) following completion of the Architectural Practice Examination.

ACADEMIC: Available to voting member academics (Associate, Member, Fellow & Life Fellow categories) working 0.6 FTE in a course of architecture.

JUST GRADUATED: First year of membership following graduation from an accredited course of architecture (Master of Architecture) or a bachelor degree providing entry to the Affiliate category. (2024-2025 graduation year).

PARENTAL LEAVE: Parents caring for a child under 5 while working less than 20 hours per week. Available to new members on application. POST-GRADUATE LEAVE: Students enrolled in a course of equal or higher AQF level than current qualification. Current members only. PART-TIME (0.4 FTE) Available to members working the equivalent of 2 days or less per week or 16 or less hours. RETIRED: Members who have substantially retired and are working less than 8 hours per week. Current members only.

^SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES: Fee reductions are available upon application for current members experiencing financial hardship due to prolonged ill-health, unemployment or performing carer's duties. Applications are assessed on the individual circumstances cited and supporting documentation is required. Current members only.
